Who is a member of PFA?

All parents, guardians or interested family members of active KWU students are elegible to be members of the PFA.

What are the benefits of PFA membership?

PFA membership provides parents and families with increased knowledge of calendar dates and campus events and activities. Families will receive e-mails with updates each semester.

What is the cost of the PFA membership?

Membership is \$20/year. Members receive a yard sign and/or decal when they register. The cost is a tax-deductible contribution to the KWU annual fund.

What are the benefits of the PFA membership?

When you become a member, you receive a yard sign or window decal as well as a quarterly email with key dates, campus updates and parent-related articles.

In addition, all parents/families are eligible for:

- Live-streaming access to athletic events
